- The minutes from the previous general meeting had a revision. Minutes were emailed to members. Asked if other revisions were needed. Motion for approval of minutes by Shiela DeFrancisco. 2nd by Sharon Rooker. Approved by membership. Minutes stand.

2. Reports

President's Report:

- The room was cleaned and inventory was taken with the help of club officers and members.

3. Ongoing Business

- Discussion was had about open drink containers in the Sewing Room. Any container that could spill liquid is not to be kept on the sewing desks. Keep those kinds of containers on either the back table or on top of the bookshelf near the bulletin board.
- The club is purchasing a new custom cabinet for AccuQuilt dies. This will allow us to have room for future purchases of more dies. The location is near the side door. This location keeps the dies safe from the heat of the window where they were being kept. It will be installed mid July.

4. New Business:

- Moving Dolly Cabinets The Dolly Mamas cabinet was moved from inside closet to hallway near side door. This was done for safety and ease of use
- Discounts for Workshop Announcement that if you attend Workshop you are eligible for a 20% discount on anything that was produced that day.
- Carrying SCA card Discussion that it's important to carry your SCA cards with you as you may be asked for them when sitting in the gallery. They won't be coming in the room to ask as they know we keep attendance.
- Class Enrollment and Waiting Lists Several classes, such as the fabric rope bowl & coaster and My Way Mola class, were fully enrolled with waiting lists, prompting discussions about managing waiting list transitions for new classes. If you are on a waiting list and an additional class is added you will have to enroll in the new class, you won't be automatically added.
- Clarification was provided that individuals who had already taken a class could not enroll for a second time, ensuring fairness for new participants
