Paper Pieced Christmas Tree (6 ½ x 6 ½ Unfinished)



Supplies:

Add a quarter ruler (preferably the 12" ruler)

Glue stick

Rotary cutter

Cutting mat

Roller/fabric presser

Universal needle #8/12

Basic quilting supplies: sewing machine, scissors, thread, etc.

Material:

Background: A fat quarter will be enough to complete one project

Christmas Tree: A variety of green fabrics. (At least 8 different fabrics.) If using scraps, strips need to be 1 ¾" wide.

Tree trunk: A 2" strip of brown fabric at least 10" long.

Cutting Instructions

Background fabric:

Two $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " (section 2 and 3)

Two 5 x 6 1/2" (section 12 and 13)

Tree trunk:

Four 2 x 2" squares (section 1)

Christmas Tree:

One 7 ½ x 1 ¾" (section 4)

One 7 x 1 3/4" (section 5)

One 6 ½ x 1 ¾" (section 6)

One 6 x 1 3/4" (section 7)

One 5 x 1 1 3/4" (section 8)

One 3 ½ x 1 ¾" (section 9)

One 2 1/2 x 1 3/4" (section 10)

One 1 ¾ x 1 ¾" (section 11)
